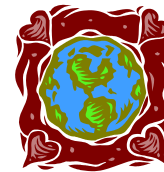
Garlic doesn't only keep vampires away. It is a natural way to keep you healthy.

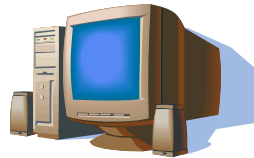
