2. Submit drawings & letter of intent to the BRZ office for approval. Letter of intent should include type of fencing, security being used and hours of operation.
3. Once approval from the BRZ is obtained you must take the drawings, intent letter and BRZ approval letter to the AGLC to obtain your permit. **You must have this patio extension permit for AGLC in order to expand your patio**
