Information Sessions Proposed Parking Requirements

Currently, commercial ground floor land uses within the Beltline and 4th St BRZ area are required to have similar parking requirements as in other parts of the city, with the exception of the Downtown. This is an issue because the Beltline has a significantly different land-use and density composition than other areas of Calgary.

As such, The City of Calgary is proposing a number of amendments addressing parking requirements and a solution catering to the needs of the Beltline urban community and the 4th St BRZ. These solutions would create a comprehensive strategy regarding the parking requirements for commercial ground floor uses.

Members of the public are invited to attend two information sessions hosted by The City of Calgary regarding these proposed Parking Requirements.
