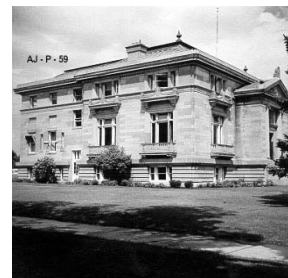

Meet Me At The Bike Racks

Check out our new bike stands installed by the City Of Calgary

These particular racks are preferred because of several key features. They are more secure and stable, have an inverted-U designed to secure wheel and frame, there are two points of contact to stabilize bicycle – this prevents damage to bike, and the round tubing which prevents cutting/theft. They are made of stainless steel with a bicycle icon and are low maintenance and easy to clean by pressure washing.
